

Golf Course formats for

Grassie Rotation

Monday November 17

Golf: 9:30am Shotgun @ SouthShore - Note bus pick up is 30 minutes earlier. Leaving by 8am

Format - 3's & 5's

Tees: Men White / Old Man Gold / Women Red

On all par 4's, Teams count the best two net scores. On the Par 3's and Par 5's, count the best 3 net scores.

Tuesday November 18

Golf: 10am Shotgun @ Spanish Trail (Canyon/Lakes) - Bus pick up is regular time of 7:50am-8:30am

Format: Wildcard

Tees: White / OM Gold / W Red

On 8 of the holes we count the best 2 net scores. On the other 10 we will be counting the best 2 + a wild card hole player. (It is 3 scores on those holes, ie. you can't double up the player that it's their hole as part of the best 2). Players must count on:

Pro – 6th Hole on both nines

Am 1 – 4th Hole on both nines

Am $2 - 3^{rd}$ Hole on both nines

Am 3 – 9th Hole on both nines

Am 4 – 2nd Hole on both nines

Wednesday November 19

Golf: 10:00am Shotgun @ Cascata -

Format: 9 & 18

Tees: Blue / Old Man White/ Women Gold

Count best two net scores on all holes except #9 and #18 where all 5 players count.

One extra wrinkle is that we have a max net bogey on those two holes only (so you don't waste too much time playing the hole).

Net Stableford Points

5 for Double Eagle/Albatross
4 for Eagle
3 for Birdie
2 for Par
1 for Bogey
0 for Double or worst

Scoring

All teams will be asked to use the AM Golf App for scoring and a hard copy scorecard. When you complete the round, please hand in your hard copy scorecard to Scott Kolb and inform him of any 2's. We play 100% of handicaps with a 15% team points reduction after the round. Max index 25 men, 28 women.

Competitions

- Team Score
- Pro Score

No individual Amateur Scores - with the exception of deuce pot

- K.P.'s on every Par 3 2 per hole
- Deuce Pot

The deuce pot is a fund that all players put in prior to their first day. Any gross 2 gets a share of the daily pot. Payment is \$20 if you are playing 3-day event and if you are playing more days, then an extra \$5 per day. Payable as you collect your tee gifts.

Payouts

The Team Pot is broken into 3 Pots worth 25% each and the remaining 25% is paid out for your three day total points. We pay 50% of the field and spread out the pot. If you place in the Top 5 on a day pot, your team payout of the daily pot the next day is limited (ie. if you win a day pot, the best payout you can receive the next day is 6th, 2nd place can only be paid 5th place and so on). The goal is to make sure the event is FUN first and not taken so seriously about winning money. Pro Pot is a cumulative 3-day point total. Playing 50% of the field.

Pace of Play

We are 5somes so we don't expect 4 hours, but we also don't expect 5+ hours. Your group should not be more than 400 yards behind the group ahead of you. We have instructed the golf clubs to be strict in keeping you in the right location. They will warn you once & only once and then the next move is to be placed into position and your team will be required to take net par on any holes you miss. Golf is more fun when you aren't waiting. Don't be that Guy/Gal that is holding the field up. We have tight schedules of buses to return to the hotel. We will have a hard stop 2:45pm Southshore, 3:15pm on the other 2 days) where groups must return to the clubhouse regardless of if they have completed the round (take net pars on any unfinished holes). Rest assured that we provide plenty of time to complete the round.

Shuttle Bus & Transfer Clubs

Following the round. It is the players responsibility to ensure they put their clubs on the clubs transfer and then hop on the bus to return to the hotel. If you need a traveler, please grab from the bar but we leave immediately following the round. On the final day, you must be on the bus your clubs are on.
